Course Description:

This 10-hour course is designed for anyone looking to enhance their news presentation skills, from recent graduates to seasoned professionals. It covers news delivery across both traditional media (TV and radio) and digital platforms, focusing on managing technical issues, staying calm under pressure, and maintaining clear, engaging delivery. Participants will build confidence in front of the camera, improve voice modulation, posture, and gestures, and engage in practical exercises to refine their performance. By the end, they'll be equipped to present news effectively across various media platforms.

Learning outcomes:

- Integrate the core principles of news presentation for both traditional media (TV/radio) and digital platforms (social media).
- Differentiate between various types of news in media and new exposure options.
- Master effective voice modulation, tonality, and clarity for news delivery.
- Improve body language and posture while presenting news, ensuring confidence and professionalism on screen.
- Adapt presentation style for various platforms.
- Develop practical skills in looking and speaking naturally on camera, enhancing their personal media presence.
- Handle technical issues and "live on air" mistakes while maintaining a calm and neutral attitude.
